Problem

Social Networking has become a major force in today's society, but its long term ramifications are yet to be known. Our profiles are increasingly becoming a major way people create an identity for themselves. This project will act as a self-portrait of you as you are defined by people in your network.

Specifications

Create a poster that displays as much information about your social network as possible. Most people's profiles contain loads of information about them - record, categorize, and display that information in an effective way. The final poster needs to be at least 11" x 17", but you are encouraged to go bigger. The final piece will be mounted on foam board with a 2 inch border, along with a digital copy of your file on the server.

Things that must be included on the poster:

A graphic of every person in your network that displays all the connections between everyone.

Optional statistics (pick at least 3):

Gender statistics
Geographic information
Race
Religion
Relationship status
Age
Political views
Any other information you find interesting

Considerations

Try to be creative in thinking about how to display the connections between people - not just people who are connected to you but which of your friends are also friends with each other. Remember to apply all the principles we learned from the textbook about color, small multiples, layering and separation, micro/macro readings, etc. Organize, organize, organize - create order!
